Tsinghua University is frequently ranked among the best universities in China. It was ranked 1st in China by Chinese University Ranking and Netbig in 2010, 2009, 2008.



WHU was ranked "best Business School in Germany" by Spiegel in a 2006 survey. The School is the only private Business School in the German-speaking area that is EQUIS certified. It's the best German Business School according to the Financial Times ranking.



K.U.Leuven has been a centre of learning for almost six centuries. Founded in 1425 by Pope Martin V, K.U.Leuven bears the dual honour of being the oldest extant Catholic university in the world and the oldest university in the Low Countries.







University of Salzburg was founded by Prince Archbishop Paris Lodron in 1622. In 2012 the university will celebrate 390th Anniversary.



Peking University as one of the best universities in China. In addition to its academics, Peking University is especially renowned for the beauty of its traditional Chinese architecture on its campus grounds.



University of St. Gallen was ranked 30th globally and 13th within Europe in the Financial Times. St. Gallen was also ranked 26th among the Global Top 200 Business Schools in QS 2010 ranking



CUPL was founded in 1952 by merging the disciplines of law, politics, and sociology from the top four universities in Beijing China. These universities include Tsinghua University, Peking University, Yenching University and Furen University.







Tongji University was established in 1907. It is one of the oldest and most prestigious institutions of higher education in China. The university has developed rapidly in all respects over the fifty years since the founding of China.

Tilburg University Faculty of Economics and Business Administration ranked #1 in Europe in 2007 according to the Journal of the European Economic Association. In the field of law, it was ranked #1 in the Netherlands according to Elsevier Magazine, and second to Cambridge University in a ranking of European law schools.



The Free University of Berlin is one of the leading and most prestigious universities in Germany and continental Europe. It won the German Universities Excellence Initiative organised by the German Federal Government with the intention of identifying and forming a German Ivy League



Beijing Normal University in 2002 signed an agreement with the Ministry of Education and Beijing Municipal Government and became the 10th university on the list of Project 985 to get special support from the Chinese Government.







Located in Beijing, the national capital of China, Renmin University of China (RUC) is a key comprehensive and research-orientated university, and also the most prestigious university in the humanities and social sciences in China's higher education.



Since the early 17th century, courses in philosophy and theology have been taught in the city. The faculty of Theology was established in 1938, whereas the department of history was founded August 1, 1989. In 1993, the faculty of humanity was established. After a popular vote, the University of Lucerne was established in 2000.



East China Normal university, one of China's key universities under the direct auspices of the Ministry of Education, is sponsored by the prestigious national program "Project 211" and "Project 985". ECNU is a high-level normal university founded in October, 1951, based on the former Great China University and Kwang Hua University, incorporated with part of Fudan University and Tongji University etc.
